And even though no other interest or necessity moves us, this truth ought to urge everyone to the word, because thereby the devil is put to flight and driven away [James 4:7].





The topic was chosen for their Families portion of the meeting, they choose the subject of bullying and then sought out a speaker and of course Brandon cannot tell his grandmother no, but he was very, very nervous. (also to add quickly, he has been invited to 2 more meetings in Hayfield and Rochester to do this again)

At first I thought that Brandon was nervous because he had to speak in front of these people, but as he read his speech I learned that his anxiety was not just from getting up in front of the group, but that he is still very sensitive in this subject and still healing.

I wish that I could have videotaped this, you and the rest of the staff at Hope needed to see this, once again I and the rest of our family were deeply touched and renewed on our belief of how your school helped Brandon.

I have attached his speech, as you read it, know that when he got to the 3rd to last statement, he took a deep breath and began to choke up a little. Note that by the time he got to the last statement, he was crying and almost didn't finish. He wept for a good 15 minutes after. I was shocked and relieved for Brandon to get his emotions out and I was very happy to see that he is healing. You truly were God-sent. We thank you with all of our hearts.
